AUSTRALIA POST GROUP BECOMES THE LATEST MAJOR AUSTRALIAN RETAILER TO SELL ZOLEO

Beam Communications Holdings Ltd (ASX: BCC, "Beam" or the "Company") is pleased to announce that it has signed a retail partnership agreement and received an initial order for ZOLEO from **Australia Post Group**, which will sell the device across participating Australia Post outlets and through their website starting in May.

Australia Post is one of the nation's largest retailers with 4,300 outlets and has a very significant presence in rural and remote regions as more than half of these outlets are located in such communities, where having a seamless global messaging device like ZOLEO would be particularly relevant.

The pocket-sized ZOLEO device will initially be available at selected regional locations and on the Australia Post website before being reviewed to progressively roll out to other Australia Post outlets in the country.

"We are proud to support Australian innovation and are pleased to be able to offer a unique device like ZOLEO to the many millions of Australians who shop at our stores and online," said Australia Post's Category Manager Telecommunications, Drew Bailey.

"ZOLEO is a unique offering and is the first of its kind product to be sold across our store network."

Australia Post is the latest strategic major Australian retailer to stock and carry the Beam-designed and developed device.

"Sales of ZOLEO in Australia is accelerating and our new partnership with Australia Post will help us build on this momentum," said Beam's managing director and chief executive officer, Michael Capocchi.

“We are also actively working on expanding ZOLEO’s reach into the government and enterprise markets where a compact and always connected messaging device will be especially useful for lone/remote worker and emergency applications.”
